The Boston Naming Test: Revised Administration and Scoring ...

The original Boston Naming Test consists of 60 black line drawings, presented in order from easiest to most difficult, that the test-taker has to identify. This test assesses word-finding ability and the cognitive functions associated with that task.

For example, the BNT has been translated to Spanish and Cantonese. Past research using the Modified Boston Naming Test-Spanish (MBNT-S; Ponton et al., 1996) has shown the test to be less sensitive to dementia-related naming impairment than a naming test developed for Spanish-speakers (e.g. Texas Naming Test [TNT]; de la Plata et al., 2008).

Naming. The Boston Naming Test (BNT) is one of the most widely used measures of naming. The original version of this test included 85 items; however, the shortened version produced in 1983 is used more frequently (Kaplan et al 1983). This test

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consists of 60 line drawings of objects of graded difficulty, ranging from very common objects (e.g. a tree) to less familiar objects such as an abacus.
