TREATMENT Initiating Therapy. Studies have shown that most dogs can be regulated with once-daily levothyroxine, 26,27 usually initiated at 0.02 mg/kg PO q24h. Some clinicians begin with twice-daily administration of levothyroxine (0.02 mg/kg PO q12h) and attempt to reduce the dosing to once daily, once clinical signs are well controlled.
