Although relatively rare in Florida, up to 11 of the 16 species of hummingbirds found in the U.S. have been seen in the state. You're most like to see the ruby-throated hummingbird, but black-chinned and rufous are occasional visitors with buff-bellied, calliope and Allen's all recorded in the Tampa Bay region.

Three species of hummingbird live in Florida through much of the year, and another two can occasionally be seen here in the winter. The most commonly seen is the ruby-throated. This feathered jewel is only about three inches long and weighs as little as a penny.

February and March (Southern U.S.) Hummingbird migration begins early in the southern United States. Areas in the Deep South, including north Florida and south Georgia, can put out hummingbird feeders as soon as the middle to late February or early March and expect to be visited by the first arriving migrants.
