Despite the many studies done to measure efficiency in hospitals . . . analysing overall efficiency, studying efficiency through services offers more accurate information about the problem, mainly because when efficiency in hospitals and medical services is measured, a wide variability of the results among the healthcare units is observed

A model to measure the efficiency of hospital performance ...

Effectiveness measures relate to services based on established medical treatments or knowledge (care that's been proven to work), efficiency measures focus on avoiding waste (waste of time, resources, or equipment), and timeliness measures evaluate the promptness of services (reducing wait times, eliminating discharge delays, etc.).
