Manual of the Mustard Seed Garden (芥子园画传, Jieziyuan Huazhuan), sometimes known as Jieziyuan Huapu (芥子园画谱), is a printed manual of Chinese painting compiled during the early-Qing Dynasty. Many renowned later Chinese painters, like Qi Baishi, began their drawing lessons with the manual. It is an important early example of colour printing.

It was first produced in a colour woodblock printed edition around 1679 in China. Wang Gai was a gifted stylist who worked in the vibrant city of Nanjing (China) in the late ...

Accordingly, a great number of painting albums were produced at that time in China (3). Amongst a multitude of albums, “Mustard Seed Garden Manual of Painting” is acclaimed as the most influential publication both in China and in Japan. In fact, the album was introduced to Japan during the Genroku era (1688-1704) in the early Edo period.

Treasures of the Library: The Mustard Seed Garden Manual ...

Manual of the Mustard Seed Garden, 芥子园画传, is the very first collection of guides about Chinese painting and is still referred to today. It shows people how to do Chinese painting in a very organised and systematic way. This set of books were first published in Qing Dynasty (* first volume was published in 1679) .


Mustard Seed Garden, a Chinese Painter's Manual : Free ...

In 1679, the author Li Yu published a primer for aspiring landscape painters called the Mustard Seed Garden Manual of Painting, and he commissioned the versatile painter Wang Gai to provide designs for the illustrations. The first edition features volumes on the components of landscape painting—trees, rocks, and human figures—with instructions on how to draw different types of each.

The Mustard Seed Garden Manual of Painting is the most influential painting book in last three hundred years in China, Japan, and Korea. Compiled by a Nanjing painter Wang Gai (or Wang Kai, 1650-1700). The first edition of 1679 consists of an introductory essay on the general principles and use of color in Chinese painting, followed by four illustrated sections on the landscape.
