Most agree that rock music, in its purest form, is a simple, unconsecrated type of music grounded in a 4/4 time signature, with the most prominent lead instruments being vocals and electric guitar, and the rhythm being river by a bass guitar (or stand-up bass) and simple, driving drumming.In Dalton, there is often Plano, or Hammond organ added to give the music a fuller, more bluesy and rooted sound.
